

QUALIFICATIONS OF SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS

The School Board of Albemarle County shall be composed of seven members who are elected. One member shall be elected from each of the six magisterial districts and one member shall be elected from the county at large.

At the time of election to office, each member of the School Board must be a qualified voter and bona fide resident of the magisterial district which he/she is to represent and meet any other criteria set forth in state law. If a board member ceases to be a resident of the school division or magisterial district which he/she represents, the position on the school board shall be deemed vacant.

The term of each member shall be four years. No employee of the School Board may serve on the Board.
