

LEGAL COUNSEL TO SCHOOL BOARD

The Albemarle County School Board's Legal Counsel shall serve as the regular attorney for the School Board and shall report to the Board. The School Board may also employ other legal counsel on an as-needed basis; in such cases, the Board's Legal Counsel shall be advised that the Board has retained other legal counsel.

The School Board's legal counsel will attend meetings of the Board and its committees upon request and will make counsel available to Board members, the Superintendent, and other school personnel as needed.

The School Board's legal counsel will serve as a member of the Superintendent's Cabinet.

The School Board's legal counsel will consult with the Albemarle County Attorney's Office when necessary, particularly with regard to matters of commonality in policy between the School Division and Local Government.
