

SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

The Albemarle County School Board (“School Board”), upon recommendation of the Superintendent, employs principals and assistant principals who hold licenses as prescribed by the Board of Education.

A principal provides instructional leadership, administers, and supervises the operation and management of the school or schools and property to which the principal is assigned, in accordance with policies of the School Board and under the supervision of the Superintendent.

A principal may submit recommendations to the Superintendent for the appointment, assignment, promotion, transfer, and dismissal of all assigned personnel.
