

MOMENT OF SILENCE

The Albemarle County School Board recognizes that a moment of silence before each school day prepares students and staff for their respective work or school days. Therefore, one minute of silence is observed in each classroom in the School Division every day.

During such period of silence, the teacher responsible for such classroom takes care that all students remain seated and silent and make no distracting display so that each student may, in the exercise of individual choice, meditate, pray, or engage in any other silent activity which does not interfere with, distract, or impede other students in the like exercise of individual choice.
