ENTRANCE AGE/ADMISSION OF PERSONS NOT OF SCHOOL AGE

A child who will reach his/her fifth birthday on or before September 30 of the school year and is otherwise eligible for enrollment in school as specified in Policy JEC may be enrolled in school. The superintendent disseminates information received from the Superintendent of Public Instruction concerning the ages when children are required or eligible to attend school. This information is disseminated to parents of such children upon or prior to enrollment of such children in the public schools of the division.

An individual who resides within the school division and is beyond school age (who has not reached his/her fifth birthday on or before September 30 of the school year or who has reached his/her 20th birthday on or before August 1 of the school year) may, at the discretion of the School Board, be admitted into the division schools. Such individuals may be charged tuition at the discretion of the School Board as provided in Policy JEC.
