Purpose

• Update of anticiated changes to accreditation for 2018-2019

Verified Credits

Five Verified Credits for both the standard and advanced diploma:

- Reading
- Writing
- Mathematics
- Science
- History

Locally verified credits may be used for the Advanced Studies and Standard diplomas.

Options for earning a verified credit in history or writing

- Pass the SOL end-of-course test or a board approved substitute <u>OR</u>
- Earn a locally awarded verified credit (no more than one per student) <u>OR</u>
- Successfully complete a locally administered authentic performance assessment

Requirements to take end-of-course tests

"Students shall not be required to take an end-of-course SOL test in an academic subject after they have earned the number of verified credits required for that academic content area for graduation, unless such test is necessary in order for the school to meet federal accountability requirements."

Growth

A student will be counted in the numerator of the reading or mathematics combined rate if:

- The student passes the assessment (recovery students still count twice); OR
- The student does not pass the assessment but demonstrates growth using the progress tables (following two slides, students must move at least one column to the right); OR
- For the reading assessment only, the student does not pass the assessment or demonstrate growth, but is an ELL and demonstrates progress as measured by the ACCESS of ELLs 2.0 assessment.

Accreditation

Pre-accreditation conditions and requirements are presented (in current regulations)

Basis of accreditation designations provided:

<u>Full Accreditation</u>: When each school quality indicator is in the green range or yellow range. For the transition year of 2018-2019, a school which meets the accreditation standards for designation as fully accredited under either the 2017-2018 accreditation calculation rules or the 2018-2019 rules for multiple school quality indicators will be so designated.

<u>Accredited with Conditions</u>: When a school has any school quality indicator in the red range

<u>Accreditation Denied</u>: When a school or school division fails to implement school division or school corrective action plans according to planned timelines, or has taken no action on identified strategies and interventions, the school is reviewed for potential designation by the board as "Accreditation Denied." The board shall deny accreditation for any school that continues to demonstrate Level Three, Red, performance levels in any school quality indicator due to a failure to implement actions prescribed in a corrective action plan.
