## **LACTATION SUPPORT**

The superintendent/designee shall designate a non-restroom location in each school, center, or department- as an area in which any personmether who is employed by the Albemarle County-BLANK School Board or enrolled as a student in the division may take breaks of reasonable length during the school day to express milk to feed a her-child until the child reaches the age of one. The area must be shielded from public view. The space must be free from intrusion with a door that locks from the inside and available when the employee or student needs to use the space. The lactation space should have a chair, a table, and an electric outlet. Ideally, tThere should be a refrigerator available for use nearby.

When possible, breaks should be scheduled during normal break and meal times and/or when the workflow allows. Supervisors/principals will work with employees/students to allow for appropriate breaks if their work schedule does not contain a break within a needed timeframe to breastfeed or express milk. Supervisors and principals will create an environment that is supportive and inclusive for lactating employees and students. Supervisors should create a supportive environment for employees so they can adequately manage their lactation responsibilities. Schools should create a supportive environment for students.
