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ADMINISTRATION GOALS

The Albemarle County School Board (<u>School Board</u>) places the primary responsibility and authority for the administration of the <u>Sechool Ddivision</u> in the <u>Seuperintendent</u>. The <u>Seuperintendent</u> is responsible for the direction, leadership and coordination of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals adopted by the School Board.

The School Board expects the division-Ssuperintendent to provide leadership in:

- 1. Decision-making.
- 2. Communication.
 - 3. Planning, organizing, implementing, and evaluating educational programs;
- 4. Defining the <u>Sechool Delivision's organizational structure</u>. All changes affecting principals and division-wide positions <u>above the director leveltwo (2)</u> reporting levels below the <u>Superintendent</u> and all licensed personnel must be approved by the School Board. Approval of other personnel will be delegated to the Superintendent/designee.
- 5. Developing and maintaining close working relationships and channels of communication within the school system and community.
