The Albemarle County School Board ("School Board"), upon recommendation of the ~~Division~~ Superintendent, employs principals and assistant principals who hold licenses as prescribed by the Board of Education.

A principal provides instructional leadership ~~in, is responsible for the administration~~ ~~administers of,~~ and supervises the operation and management of the school or schools and property to which ~~the principal is~~ ~~he/she has been~~ assigned, in accordance with ~~policies the rules and regulations~~ of the School Board and under the supervision of the ~~Division~~ Superintendent.

A principal may submit recommendations to the ~~Division~~ Superintendent for the appointment, assignment, promotion, transfer, and dismissal of all assigned personnel. ~~assigned to his/her supervision.~~
