Tier 2

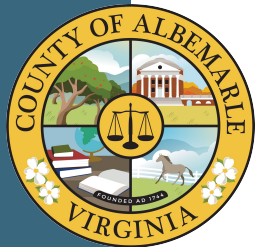
Beginning no earlier than June, members resume in-person, “virtual access” for attendees

EDA, ABBA, ARB, BZA, BOE

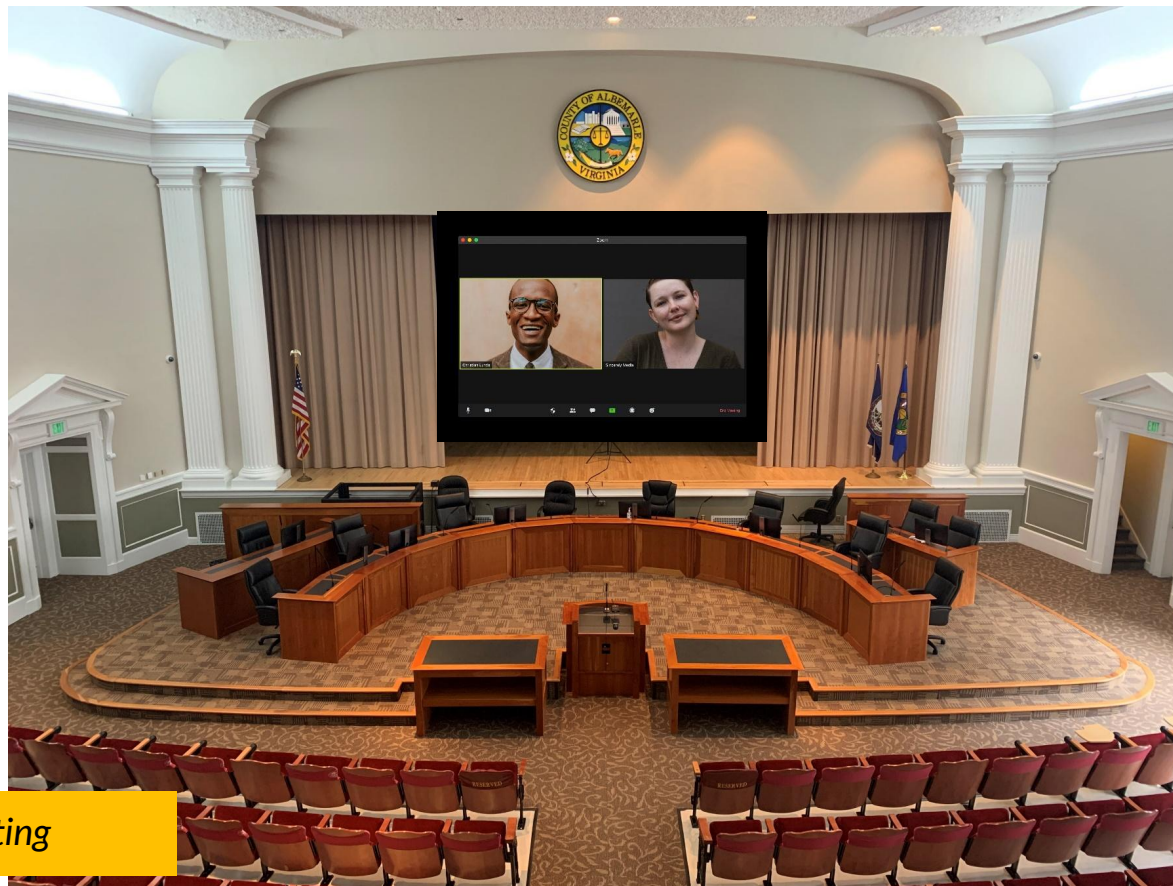
Tier 3

Dais area: 10

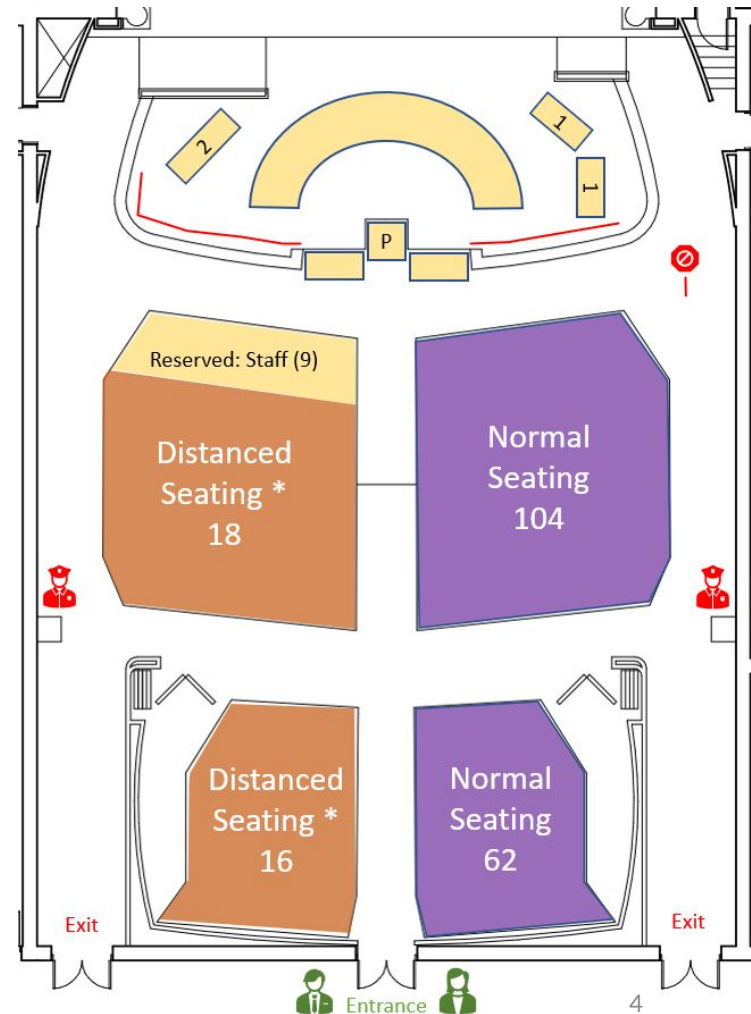
Reserved for staff: 9

*Presence of family groups may increase occupancy in distanced seating areas

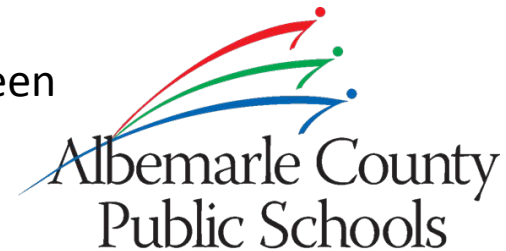


School Board Meeting Highlights

- ❖ First in-person School Board Meeting will be **April 14, 2022** in Lane Auditorium at the County Office Building (COB)
- ❖ Mask requirement will be dependent on the requirements at COB at the time of the meeting.
- ❖ Meeting will be streamed live on ACPS website (same as current practice)
- ❖ The public will have three options to participate in public comment:
 - In-person
 - Electronically via Zoom
 - Written Submission

Public Comment via Zoom or In-Person

- ❖ School Board Clerk will admit speakers to Zoom when it is time to speak
- ❖ Everyone in the auditorium will be able to hear the speaker
- ❖ The Zoom participant will be displayed on each board member's laptop screen as well as the auditorium screen, provided the speaker's camera is turned on
- ❖ The Zoom participant can view the board members via the meeting stream (while they are speaking the stream should be muted)
- ❖ The Zoom participant will see the ACPS logo on their Zoom screen
- ❖ In-Person public comment will resume with no changes
