Faculty meetings are valuable opportunities for the school's professional learning community. ~~These meetings are among the few times that the entire staff is together~~ to build relationships ~~amongwith other~~ staff ~~members,~~ ~~to~~ focus on professional development, ~~and/or to~~ solve problems, and make decisions.

Attendance at faculty meetings and other meetings called by the administrative staff is a ~~duty~~ job responsibility and shall be regarded as a part of the working day of those employees of the School Board ~~asked to who~~ attend. A minimum expectation of one (1) faculty meeting per month of during the school year will be established by ~~the~~ administrative staff ~~team~~. Attendance at these meetings ~~shall be~~ is mandatory unless the employee is specifically excused ~~by the person calling the meeting by the meeting's organizer~~. Any non-exempt employee required to attend a work-related meeting shall be compensated for the meeting time in accordance with the Fair Labor Standards Act. Normally, faculty meetings will be scheduled in advance so that ~~teachers~~ staff can ~~schedule~~ plan personal time to accommodate attendance ~~when~~ outside of regular work hours.

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
