## **FACULTY MEETINGS**

Faculty meetings are valuable opportunities for the school's professional learning community. These meetings are among the few times that the entire staff is together to build relationships among with other staff members, to focus on professional development, and/or to solve problems, and make decisions.

Attendance at faculty meetings and other meetings called by the administrative staff is a dutyjob responsibility and shall be regarded as a part of the working day of those employees of the School Board asked to who attend. A minimum expectation of one (1) faculty meeting per month of during the school year will be established by the administrative staffteam. Attendance at these meetings shall beis mandatory unless the employee is specifically excused by the person calling the meeting by the meeting's organizer. Any non-exempt employee required to attend a work-related meeting shall be compensated for the meeting time in accordance with the Fair Labor Standards Act. Normally, faculty meetings will be scheduled in advance so that teachers staff can scheduleplan personal time to accommodate attendance when outside of regular work hours.
