To the School Board Members of Albemarle County Public Schools:

I wish to express my interest in serving as the White Hall Magisterial District School Board member following the recent resignation of Mr. David Oberg. If appointed to this one-year term, I can confirm that I am also interested in seeking election in the subsequent three-year term. Given my life-long devotion to education, School Board service is something that I have been contemplating for some time, although as a newer United States citizen, this is the first time that I have been eligible for consideration.

As an experienced board member including multiple leadership roles as Chair, I will be effective in building consensus as I understand how to negotiate compromise and put aside personal opinions in the process of realistic policy development. My formal training and career experiences have also prepared me well to build relationships and appropriately engage and communicate with stakeholders holding varied perspectives and competing interests. While stakeholder engagement is critical, I also appreciate that optimal Board outcomes are also shaped by broad and open discussions amongst members who often convey disparate perspectives stemming from the constituents they represent. Given this, I fully commit to engaging in this process collegially and in adhering to the responsibilities of a board member in maintaining confidentiality of executive processes as required.

As a life-long scholar, I realize that the more I learn, the more I am aware of limitations of my current knowledge. I understand that there will be Board procedures and current or future issues that I am unfamiliar with. However, I can assure the Board that I am committed to invest the time and effort needed to make informed decisions. To do this, I will use my training and experience in data sciences and statistics to harness the power of distilling complex data to guide decisions. I will also use my decades long experience as a scientist in being comfortable with (the discomfort of) making decisions in the face of competing hypotheses and contradictory, new or evolving evidence. I will listen, learn, weigh and consider, and then decide what action (vote) is optimal, all things considered.

As an experienced educator, holding secondary school teaching qualifications in Virginia and a wealth of national and international experience at the post-secondary level and beyond, I greatly value the pathway to life's success that accessible and effective public education creates. At the same time, I am keenly aware and deeply concerned about the struggle too many children endure, and will continue to face as adults, when public education does not live up to standards. My primary goal as a School Board member will be to make decisions, including the courage to make difficult decisions, to best support staff and enable the education system to deliver optimal public education.

Lastly, as someone raised by a young widowed parent who did not complete high school while living in an isolated rural region, and as someone with years of first-hand experience as an adult living, working or raising a young family in global regions where my language, ethnicity, religion or culture were not dominant, I will continue to reflect on the totality of my formative experiences to infuse empathy and compassion into my term of Board service.
